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A Brief Message from the MWLTC Board of Directors:

Inspired by God, John wrote the Good News story from a unique perspective, different from the other three gospel writers. We hope you are blessed by your diligent study of this book. We also hope that this study guide is a useful aid.

As students of scripture (just like you), we think words are important, especially when those words are inspired scripture. In this study guide, you may notice several questions that refer to one particular man as “John the baptist”. However, in the NIV translation on which this study guide is based, the phrase “John the baptist” never appears in the book of John. In fact, from our research, we think it never even appears in the Greek manuscripts of John’s gospel. **Should a study guide on John use phrases and terminology that is not even found in the book itself?** (*Good question!*)

On one hand, staying close to the Biblical text is very important to us. On the other hand, having two men with the same name can easily cause confusion for everyone – “John” (the author and one of the twelve) and “John” (the man that prepared the way for Jesus).

For MWLTC, we have decided not to change any questions or answers in the HOALTC study guide that refer to “John the baptist”. This decision is based on two reasons, primarily:

- (1) We do not intend for the Bible Bowl event to confuse students. Rather, it is intended to provide an incentive for students to diligently study scripture.
- (2) The term “John the baptist” is indeed found in scripture, just not the book of John. In fact, it is used some 14 times in Matthew, Mark, and Luke (in the Greek and in the NIV). Thus, we have good reason to be confident that it is a Biblical term.

We should also mention that we’ve made a few other minor departures from the HOALTC study guide. We have removed seven questions that rely on footnotes for the answer, plus about 13 others. We have also made minor changes to about 25 questions or answers.
